Isle Royale Population Study Background: Moose where first recorder over a 100 years ago on Isle Royale, this is a small island (45 miles long by 9 miles wide) located in Lake Superior. In roughly 1949, due to a thick ice pack on Lake Superior, timber wolves crossed the ice pack and began to live on Isle Royale.

The Isle Royale wolf population was founded when wolves crossed an ice bridge from Canada in about 1949. They were believed to have been isolated ever since. Comprised typically of just a couple dozen wolves, the population is also small. Small, isolated populations exhibit high rates of inbreeding, which means to mate with close relatives.

In this lab, you will explore populations of predators and prey using a simplified simulation model of the Isle Royale system. The Isle Royale model involves three species: plants, moose, and wolves. The "plants" in the model represent moose food.

The wolves of Isle Royale face a decrease in genetic diversity from isolation. Due to a lack of more alleles in the gene pool and the severe lack of females in the pack, wolf in-breeding is a common practice on Isle Royale. This leads to genetic mutations in their spine, and a lower life expectancy.

Reintroducing a thriving wolf population to Isle Royale also has an effect on the island's other residents, which include beavers and foxes. Wolves eat beavers as well as moose; and so, the beaver population, which has been booming since 2012, may eventually decline to levels of a decade ago, about 20% of current numbers.
