To summarize the solution: 1. Make sure to use a fully qualified name, including the file name for both the destination and the source. (e.g. C:\Source\file.ext, C:\Destination\file.ext) 2. Visual Studio should run with the same access rights as the folders you are trying to access.

Solution Folders only seem to be "virtual folders", because they are not really created in the Filesystem and files inside solution folders are just sitting in the same folder as the .sln file.

Here is an incredibly simple solution that worked for me. It may work for you as well: In Windows Explorer: choose Tools, Folder Options > Click the Search tab > Check or uncheck ANY option. Apply.
